
This national assessment program allows schools, parents and students to be further informed as to their progress in all assessment areas. Best wishes to our Year 3 & 5 students who are participating in the program.

Then you may be eligible to apply for the CSEF (CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND)
